

REPORT OF THE REVIEW COMMITTEE ON ORAL AND MAXILLOFACIAL PATHOLOGY EDUCATION TO THE COMMISSION ON DENTAL ACCREDITATION

CONSIDERATION OF MATTERS RELATED TO ORAL AND MAXILLOFACIAL PATHOLOGY EDUCATION

Informational Report on Frequency of Citings of Accreditation Standards for Advanced Dental Education Programs in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology (p. 800): The Review Committee on Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology Education (OMP RC) considered the annual report on the frequency of citings of the Accreditation Standards for Advanced Dental Education Programs in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology. One (1) area of non-compliance was cited during the reporting period, which was under Standard 4-5.3 related to trainees actively participating in the gross and microscopic examination of surgical and necropsy specimens.

Subsequent to the meeting, the Review Committee learned that, due to an error, the Frequency of Citings report found in **Appendix 1, Policy Report p. 800** included information from both the prior and current Accreditation Standards within a single appendix. The OMP RC was informed that the citings report has been updated to reflect the termination of the January 1, 2014 Standards and the adoption and implementation of the August 6, 2021 Standards as a result of the most recent Validity and Reliability Study. Therefore, **Appendix 1** concludes the Frequency of Citings for the January 1, 2014 Accreditation Standards for Advanced Dental Education Programs in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology. There were 14 oral and maxillofacial pathology site visits from January 1, 2014 through August 5, 2021 as noted in **Appendix 1**. The report on the Frequency of Citings for the Accreditation Standards for Advanced Dental Education Programs in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology implemented August 6, 2021 is found in **Appendix 2**. There have been two (2) oral and maxillofacial pathology site visits conducted from August 6, 2021 through October 31, 2021 as noted in **Appendix 2**. To ensure confidentiality, Frequency of Citings reports will not be made available where a limited number (three or less) of programs have been site visited. The Commission will continue to receive reports annually summarizing the updated data on the frequency of citings of individual Standards.

Recommendation: This report is informational in nature and no action is required.
